The following was discussed:

- 1) This Saturday's ride in west dessert to look for mustangs

- 6) How to tie a High Line was discussed and demonstrated
- 7) How to tie a Sheep Shank was demonstrated and putting a stick in the knot to make untying the knot easier.
- 8) Additional ways of constraining a horse such as staking out, corral panels, and electric fence
- 9) Using Mule Tape was suggested for a high-line
- 10) How to use hobbles was discussed and demonstrated
  - a. Types of hobbles discussed included leather, rope, T-shirt, nylon, and Mormon Hobbles
