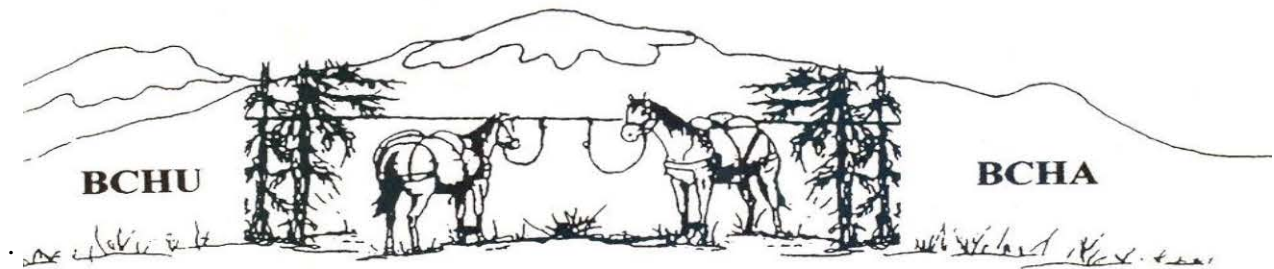

State General Membership Meeting

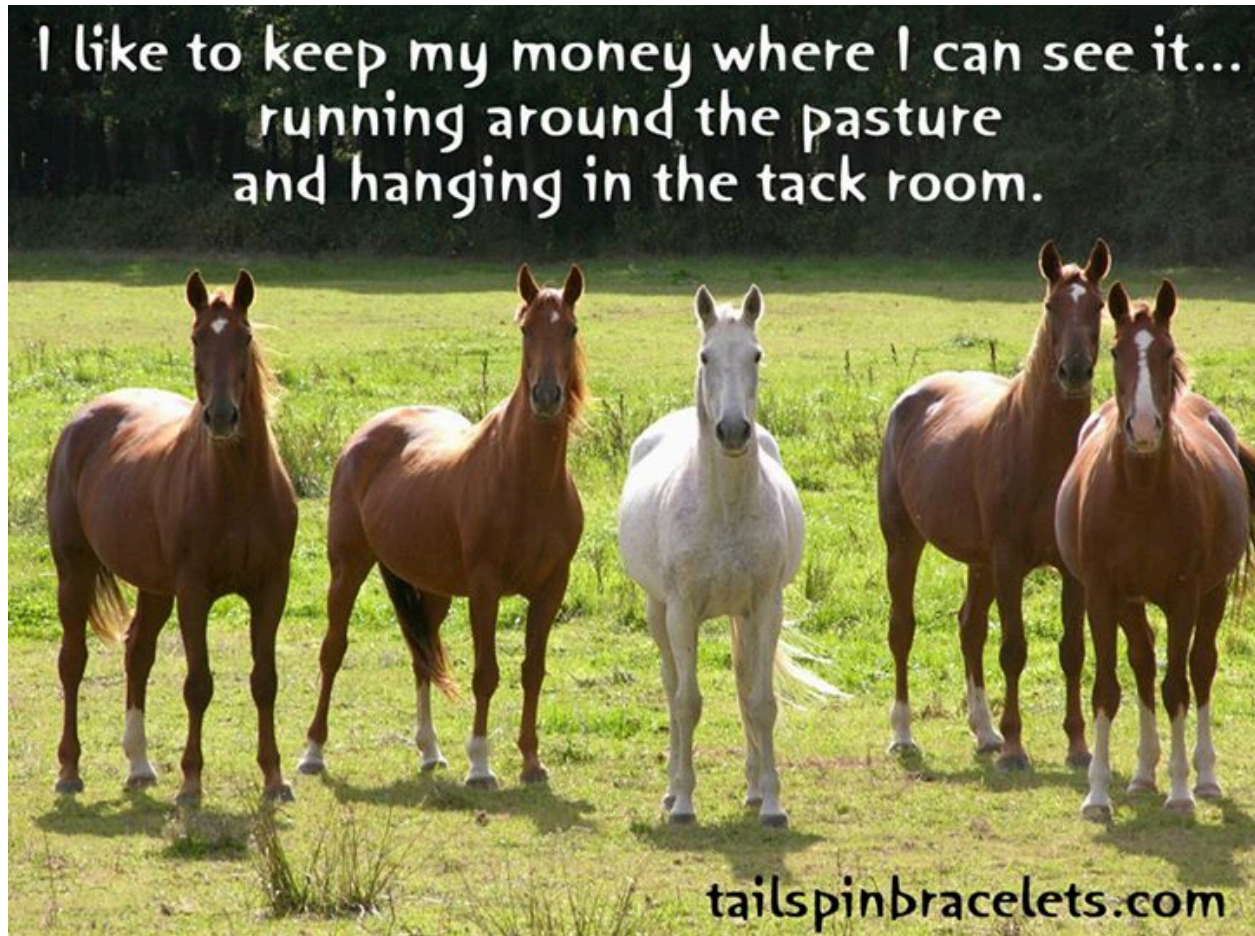
